

Run order will be drawn on May 24<sup>th</sup>. **Correct entry fee must accompany an official, signed, and FULLY completed ASCA entry to be considered a valid entry.** Forms are available on the ASCA website. <u>www.asca.org</u> Day of show entries will be allowed if space is available. A waiting list will be established if the trial fills. **Entry fees will only be refunded if the trial AND your spot is filled.** Bitches in heat will run in the order of the draw.

**Directions:** From I-35 North: Take 35 North to Exit 165/County Road 70 (Rock Creek Exit). Head east (right) till you reach the 4 way stop. At the stop take 361 North (left). Follow 361N to County Road 117 /Liberty Road (1.3 mi). Head east (right) on 117/Liberty Road. Follow the road until it stops (2 mi). Head north (left) on County Road 4/Military Road/Government Road. This is a paved road. From County Road 4 head north until you reach Russell Road (.6 mi). Head east (right) on Russell Road. Elysian Farm will be the 3<sup>rd</sup> house on your right (.6 mi). ### SHEEP FARM TRIAL

#### 1. Pen Work – 25 points

8 head of sheep will be put into pen D. Dog and handler will take all head from Pen D and put into Pen E.

#### 2. Location specific task – trailer – 15 points

- Open Handler/ Dogs will put all sheep into stock trailer. They will have a 12 foot wing on the northwest side of trailer.
- Advanced handler/dogs will put all sheep into stock trailer. No wing will be used.

#### 3. Gather work – 25 points

Take stock thru gate 1 and put into 100 x 200 arena. Take sheep to post 3 and settle with a pan of grain.

- Open handler may go to Post 2. Dog must stay at Post 1 until sent. Handler will send dog for outrun and bring sheep to Post 1.
- Advanced handler /dog will got to Post 1. Handler must stay at post and send dog for outrun and bring sheep to Post 1

### 4. Chute work – 25 points

Take stock thru Chute entering thru east end. Mark 3 head of sheep.

#### 5. Location specific task – Hold – 15 points

Take stock to marked hold area. Stock must be in hold area and settled until judge calls "Hold"

#### 6. Sort work – 25 points


Take sheep to Gate 2. Put 3 marked head into Pen A. Put 3 unmarked head into Pen B. Put 2 unmarked head into Pen C. Put all 8 sheep back into Pen C. Dog and handler may use any combination of gates and pens to accomplish above. Trial completed when all 8 head are in Pen C and all gates are closed.

- Time limit is 15 minutes, with a 3 minute warning. Open and Advanced Farm trial dogs must earn 70% or more of the total points (91/130) to qualify. Dogs must earn their open farm title before entering the advanced farm trial class.
- Ties will be broken by the sort work score.

#### SHEEP RANCH TRIAL

 Pen work – Part A (Note: a total of 20 points between Part A and Part B) Ten head of sheep will start out in Pen A. 3 head will be marked before run starts. Dog and handler will move sheep from Pen A to Pen B.

### 2. Sort work – 20 points

Take 3 marked head of sheep and put into Pen D. Any combination of Pen A, B, C, D, E and Gate 1 may be used to accomplish. Once sheep are sorted, put all sheep back together and put them into pen E.

#### 3. Pasture work – 40 points

Take sheep out of Pen E and put into Field F thru Gate 2. Fetch or drive sheep clockwise around perimeter of Field F and past Post Z.

#### 4. Chute work – 20 points

Load all head of stock thru chute and into stock trailer. Take stock out of stock trailer

#### 5. Pen work – Part B


Take stock thru Gate 3 and Gate 4 and put into Pen G. Ranch trial is completed when all stock are in Pen G and all gates are closed.

- Time limit is 20 minutes, with two warnings (one at 10 minutes and one at 5 minutes).
- A qualifying score is earned by any dog receiving 75% or more of total score. A dog that has qualified at a Sheep Ranch Trial earns the right to use the title RTDs.
